 - ix. Innovsource to include The S.I.A College of Higher Education in all communications (external and internal) with its clients in the selection process.
- x. This MoU shall be exclusively between Innovsource & The S.I.A College of Higher Education for the next 36(Thirty-Six) Months from the date of signing. Innovsource will in its fullest capacity try to ensure a hassle-free drive.
- xi. Innovsource would be putting up Banners / Standees and posters at strategic locations within The S.I.A College of Higher Education premises.
- xii. Innovsource will not share students' details with any third-party employment agencies. It will be used only by Innovsource group companies for placement across their clientele.

1. Nature of Collaboration

2. Mutual Obligations



- 2.2 Each party shall respect the other's Intellectual Property and shall not use any trade name, trademark, symbol, or designation belonging to the other without prior written permission of the other. Further each party shall also respect the other party's confidential information that is shared during the processes under this MOU which the receiving party shall not disclose without the prior approval of the disclosing party.
- 2.3 The S.I.A College of Higher Education shall, subject to the applicable Law indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless Innovsource, its affiliates and their officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives from and against any and all claims, liabilities, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) incurred or suffered, or to be incurred or suffered by any of them due to any fraud, negligence, misconduct, misrepresentation, malpractice, material deviation, malfeasance, misuse of intellectual property and confidential information or nonfeasance by The S.I.A College of Higher Education or its personnel.
- 2.4 Nothing contained in this MoU shall be construed as resulting in the creation of a relationship of principal and agent between The S.I.A College of Higher Education and Innovsource.
- 2.5 The S.I.A College of Higher Education & Innovsource is not authorized to make any representation, contract, or commitment on behalf of each other without prior written consent.
- 2.6 Intellectual Property:

As between both the parties, Innovsource will have and retain ownership of all right, title and interest to technology and intellectual property developed by Innovsource, its Affiliates and their personnel, whether relating to the Patent Rights and Technology.

2.7 Offer extended by clients are subjected to be withdrawn due to business cases, Innovsource nor client to be held responsible or any monetary claim will be entertained.

3. General

- 3.1 Both parties shall not use the name of the other in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- 3.2 Both parties agree that Innovsource is not obliged on account of this MoU to offer employment fulltime or part time to employees of The S.I.A College of Higher Education or any candidate.
- 3.3 Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MoU with a written notice period of 30 (Thirty) Days to other party without any compensation or legal redress, after the lapse of obligatory period of one year.

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (herein after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 25th of February month 2022, by and between

(herein after referred to as "Second Party",

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties'

WHEREAS:

The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between

- 9. Training & Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party & affiliated colleges and employees of both the organizations.
- 10. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of second party(Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party
- 11. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 12. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 13. Curriculum Design: First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customise the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 14. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the trainings to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development
- 15. Skill Development Programs: First Party to train the students of second Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 16. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 17. Faculty Development Programs: First Party to train the faculties of second Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 18. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 19. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation.
- 20. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.
- 21. In case, second party wants to conduct customized commercial trainings then this agreement can be amend/adding annexure with mutually agreed terms.

This document constitutes a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between TNS India Foundation (TNSIF) and The SIA College of Higher Education, Mumbai for a 2 year period between 2020-2022.

The SIA College of Higher Education, Mumbai affiliated to the University of Mumbai, Mumbai, Maharashtra, managed under the The South Indian Association Trust registered under The Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950 and hereinafter referred to as "The College", having PAN AAATT4829Q located at Gymkhana Rd, Azde Gaon, Gograswadi, Dombivli East, Maharashtra, 421203 represented by its Principal, Dr. Padmaja Arvind.

AND

TNS India Foundation, a charitable organization registered under section 25 of the Companies Act 1956 and having its registered office at B1-201, Centre Point, Opposite Bawla Masjid, 243A, N M Joshi Marg, Lower Parel (E), Mumbai-400 013, hereinafter referred as "**TNSIF**", represented by its Director, Punit Gupta.

Background

TNS India Foundation (TNSIF), a section 25 Company incorporated under the provision of The Companies Act, 1956 is conducting a "Campus to Corporate Careers (C2C) Program" for enhancement of employability and workplace skills for deserving youth.

In this connection, TNSIF intends to be associated and work closely with the College to conduct employability training and career counseling sessions for the final year college students. This will include activities through the year, till students are placed 10-12 months after their final year examinations. Features of the program are as follows:

- 1. 55 80 hours of training program including Personal Effectiveness (goal setting, interpersonal relationships), Personal Finance, Professional effectiveness (how to choose right career option, how to apply for job, tools-CVs, cover letter- etc.), Business communication (effective communication with co-workers and customers), Career Readiness (orienting students to jobs matching their skill sets and exposure to a career path) and Work Readiness (Professionalism, Work Ethics, Email Etiquettes, Workplace dynamics etc.)
- 2. 55 80 hours of training will be delivered via Blended Learning approach i.e online mode using platforms like Zoom and in-class training. A few hours of additional training will be available to students on TNSIF's proprietary online learning platform. The program also includes individual student counselling during the program, which will be conducted via Online/Offline platforms, as well as post training, pre-placement and post-placement counselling.
- 3. Training or post-training interaction sessions will be conducted in the college premises when TNSIF and the College deem fit.
- 4. There is no cost for students to attend the above mentioned training.
- 5. Each training batch size will be about 30-35 students. Sessions of duration 2 hours each to be conducted 5 days per week. Training to be conducted for 2 or more batches in one day through one TNSIF trainer.
- 6. Counselling support is available on training days for providing career guidance to students who are enrolled in this program.









- 7. Students will be provided a certificate on successful completion of course with minimum attendance criteria of 90%.
- 8. Students will be further supported in job linkages and placements from the time of training completion till they are placed i.e. 6-10 months after their training is complete.
- 9. College is expected to support the successful training and placements of all students, should they take up this service with TNSIF.

For this purpose, TNSIF requires support of the college in the following areas:

- 1. Facilitating discussions and engagement with the current third year degree students and graduates wherever feasible. This involves the following:
 - a. Assistance in student mobilization and batch scheduling with ongoing final year classes.
 - b. Support in allocating batches (of about 30-35 students approximately) per trainer for optimum utilization of resources and training effectiveness.
 - c. Provide assistance w.r.t. conducting career fests drive and continued student participation.
- 2. Infrastructure support for the following:
 - a. Availability of classroom to conduct post training engagement sessions and refresher sessions as and when required once the situation normalises.
 - b. Require college support to conduct a Parent engagement session in the college premises or via Online Platform.

Upon a request by TNSIF for this support, **the College** has agreed to support and provide the appropriate assistance to TNSIF, as mentioned below.

Based on the above, this MOU lays out immediate next steps to be taken by both parties.

TNSIF agrees to -

- 1. Conduct Orientation sessions to make students aware about the program and register their interest.
- 2. Engage with students and form batches based on selection criteria for conducting the training program.
- 3. Conduct the Campus to Corporate Careers Program using online platforms.
- 4. Provide career counselling support to students enrolled in this program.
- 5. Facilitate further linkages with vocational training partners and employers for interested students.
- 6. Placement reports of students linked to job opportunities will be provided to the college once placement activities commence.

The College agrees to -

- 1. Facilitate the dissemination of information regarding the C2C Program to the final year or recent graduates and help TNSIF to mobilise students.
- 2. Permit Online sessions to be conducted via Zoom or any application deemed appropriate.
- 3. Providing one contact point who could be approached for any support (student engagement) related to

- The purpose of this MOU is to build friendship and goodwill and foster a relationship that will promote mutual intellectual exchanges between students, faculty members and administrators of The S.I.A. College, Dombivli (East), Thane, Maharashtra and St. Aloysius College, Jabalpur.
- 2. In an effort to experience the lifelong learning process, both parties are prepared to participate in a formal exchange programme that seeks to promote an academic exchange and to provide collaboration in:
 - This exchange programme encompasses, but is not limited to, the promotion of:
 - a. Exchange of Faculty Members and students.
 - b. The organization of joint research projects and publications
 - Collaboration in the area of education and continuing education including curriculum development and co-curricular activities.
 - d. Conduct of and participation in seminars, conferences, symposiums and faculty training programmes
 - Other academic exchanges such as Skill Development, Best Practices etc. to which both the institutions may agree.
 - ii. The implementation of any and all exchange programmes will be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions by way of separate agreement and shall be subject to applicable UGC Regulation/s.
 - Participation in the exchange programme will continue as long as both institutions deem the experience mutually beneficial. It is the intent and desire of both institutions to continue to develop inter-disciplinary knowledge relations and intellectual growth through the exchange of people and ideas.
 - 3. Both parties are responsible for their own costs in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding unless otherwise agreed. However, while on account of the MOU, registration fees for any programme/activity, if any, will be waved-off mutually, the hosting institution will assist the



travelling/visiting institution in making all arrangements with regards to local travel, accommodation etc. (with the cost to be borne by the visiting institution).

- the S.I.A. College and SAC affirm this MOU by the signature of their officials duly authorized to enter into and to implement the same.
- 5. This MOU will become effective from the date herein mentioned above and shall remain valid for a period of three years unless either Party terminates the same on three month's written notice to the other. Notwithstanding any such termination, any programme that is being implemented under Clause 2 (ii) above shall continue till its full completion.
- 6. This MOU will be reviewed at the end of the third year and subject to mutual consensus may be renewed on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed.
