4. The Practice

Activities conducted under Eco-club

a) Outbound learning-Sensitivity towards environment:

Eco-club organized field visit tour at college campus with the objective to create environmental awareness among students. The participants came to know about various green initiatives taken by the college to save environment. Save, recycle and reuse water as and when possible.

b) Electronic Waste Collection Drive:

Students participated in this community outreach programme and collected e-waste from their neighbors, friends, relatives, and family. After collecting e-waste, Students brought collected e-waste at the e-waste collection point located at the Ground floor where a large drop box was kept accumulating all the e-waste items collected.

Through this community outreach program, students became aware and shared with the community about the hazards of e-waste recycling by the unorganized sector and educated them about alternate methods of disposing their e-waste.

c) Green initiative of disposing e-waste:

e-Incarnation Recycling Pvt. Ltd. recycling company was invited to collect and dispose off e-waste in an eco-friendly manner and provide us with destruction certificate.

d) Celebration of International World Water Day
Eco-Club in collaboration with Hariyali (NGO) on account of the International World Water Day on 22nd March 2022 the Eco-club had organized the screening of Videos related to importance of Water and its conservation, thus an awareness was generated among the students regarding the conservation of the Water. This drive generated revenue of Rs.7650/- which was deposited in college fund.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required




6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required
