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
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
Suggestions

Feedback Analysis

- 89% of Graduate students and 11 % of Postgraduate students gave feedback on the Curriculum.
- 83.5% students from commerce ,12.2% from science ,1.7% from Arts and 2.6% from others gave feedback.
- \blacktriangleright 68.7% were male respondents and 31.3% were female respondents.
- > 27% of respondents gave an excellent rating, 34.8% gave a very good rating
- 32.2% gave a good rating, 5.2% gave a poor rating and 0.9% gave a very poor rating for curriculum in terms of securing jobs.
- 32.5% of respondents gave an excellent rating, 36.8% gave a very good rating, 25.4% gave a good rating, 4.4% gave a poor rating, 0.9% gave a very poor rating for the Course stimulates my interest and thought on the subject area
- 30.4% gave an excellent rating,34.8% gave a very good rating,30.4% gave a good rating, and 4.3% gave a poor rating for The syllabus of the course is intellectually enriching
- 31.6% gave an excellent rating,31.6% gave a very good rating, 28.1% gave a good rating,7% gave a poor rating and 1.8% gave a very poor rating for Syllabus provides hands-on experience.




1 .The content of the syllabus is appropriate for the need of industry 22 responses

Analysis:

- Majority of the respondents agreed that the content of the syllabus is appropriate for the needs of the industry with 50%(11 respondents) and 36.4%(8 respondents) rating it 4 and 3 respectively in the 5 point likert scale.
- 4.5 % (1 respondent) has rated 5 and 9.1%(2 respondents) have rated 2 in the likert scale.

Interpretation: The majority of the faculty believe that the syllabus is abreast with the needs of the industry. However there should be timely revisions to keep with the latest developments and changes in the industry.




2. The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment 22 responses

Analysis:

- Majority of the respondents agree that the evaluation methods are sufficient for providing proper assessment with 45.5% (10 respondents) rating it as 3 and 4 each in the 5 point likert scale.
- 1 respondent (4.5%) each has rated the statement as 2 and 5.

Interpretation: Majority of the teachers believe that the evaluation methods consisting of external and continuous assessment as prescribed by the university enables proper and continuous assessment.

3. The theory and practical components of the syllabus are well balanced 22 responses




Analysis:

- Majority of the respondents agree that the theory and practical components of the syllabus are well balanced with 36.4% (8 respondents) rating it as 3 and 4 each in the 5 point likert scale.
- 4.5% (1 respondent) and 22.7% (5 respondents) have rated the statement as 1 and 2 respectively.

Interpretation: Majority of the respondents believe that the syllabus gives importance to both practical and theoretical aspects.


4. The Course stimulates student's interest and thought on the subject area 22 responses



Analysis:

- Majority of the respondents agree that the course stimulates students' interest and thought in the subject area with 59.1% (13 respondents) and 31.8% (7 respondents) rating it as 4 and 3 respectively in the 5 point likert scale.
- 4.5% (1 respondent) has rated the statement as 1 and 2 each.

Interpretation: The course syllabus stimulates student's interest and thought on the subject area.




5..The books prescribed for reference are relevant, appropriate and updated 22 responses

Analysis:

• Majority of the respondents agree that the books prescribed for reference are relevant, appropriate and updated with 22.7% (5 respondents), 36.4% (8 respondents) and 40.9% (9 respondents) rating it as 5, 4 and 3 respectively in the 5 point likert scale.

Interpretation: Appropriate books are prescribed for reference as part of syllabus.

6.Time allotted for each unit is adequate for the completion of syllabus 22 responses




Analysis:

- 36.4% (8 respondents) have rated 3 and 4 each in the 5 point likert scale to the statement that time allotted for each unit is adequate for completion of syllabus.
- 18.2% (4 respondents) and 4.5% (1 respondent) have rated the above statement as 2 and 1 respectively in the 5 point likert scale.
- 4.5% (1 respondent) has rated the above statement as 5.

Interpretation: Majority of the faculty agree that the allotted lectures are evenly spread among the units of the syllabus. However in case of certain subjects, more time may be required to complete the unit.


7.The topics of the syllabus are upgraded with current scenario 22 responses



Analysis:

- 54.5% (12 respondents) and 22.7% (5 respondents) have rated 3 and 4 each in the 5 point likert scale to the statement that the topics of the syllabus are upgraded with the current scenario.
- 13.6% (3 respondents) and 4.5% (1 respondent) have rated the above statement as 2 and 1 respectively in the 5 point likert scale.
- 4.5% (1 respondent) has rated the above statement as 5.

Interpretation: Majority of the faculty are neutral to the statement as to whether the topics of the syllabus are upgraded with current scenario.



8.Syllabus gives scope to teachers to adopt new and different techniques of teaching 22 responses

Analysis:

- 45.5% (10 respondents) and 36.4% (8 respondents) have rated 4 and 3 each in the 5 point likert scale to the statement that the syllabus gives scope to teachers to adopt new and different techniques of teaching.
- 9.1% (2 respondents) have rated the above statement as 2 in the 5 point likert scale.
- 9.1% (2 respondents) rated the above statement as 5.

Interpretation: Majority of the faculty believe that the syllabus gives scope to teachers to adopt new and different techniques of teaching.


some of the suggestions received from the teachers are as follows:



Current curriculum is suitable to meet the industry requirements?








There is a gap between industry requirement and curriculum implementation

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

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

Suggestions to improve the curriculum to satisfy industry requirements?








What add on courses a student is expected to complete for your organisation/industry to employ him?








Interpretation:



3. How it is useful for subject domain skill enhancement?

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

- 5. 4% of the respondents has given poor rating




4.How curriculum is helpful to perform your daily work activities? 50 responses
