

- To assess students overall level of satisfaction on different aspects of the curriculum offered and facilities provided by the institution to enrich the curriculum.



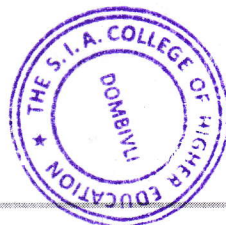

Employer:3	The gap between the industry and the academia to be reduced

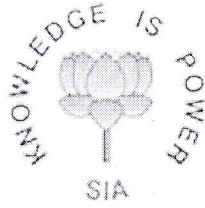

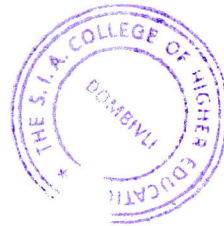


ACTION TAKEN REPORT - CURRICULUM FEEDBACK 2023-24

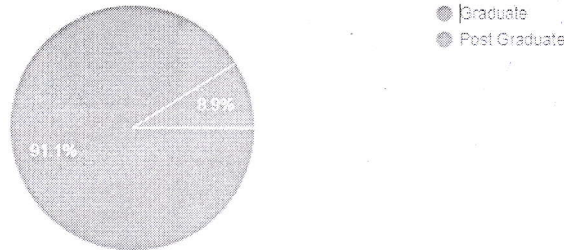

Degree

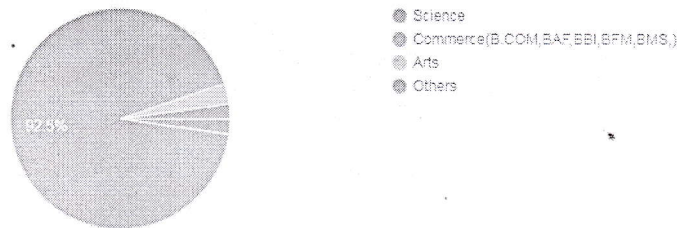
336 responses

Course

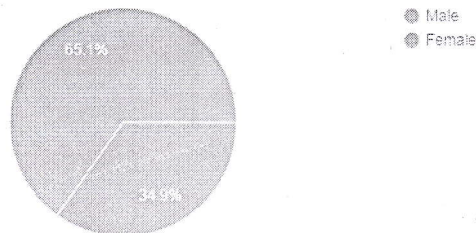
361 responses

Out of 361 responses 34.9 % are male respondents and 65.1% are female respondents.

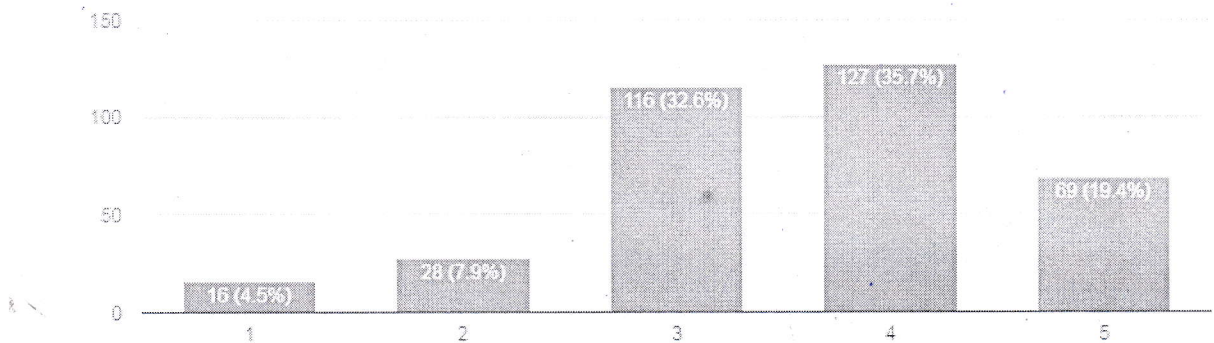


Curriculum rating in terms of securing job

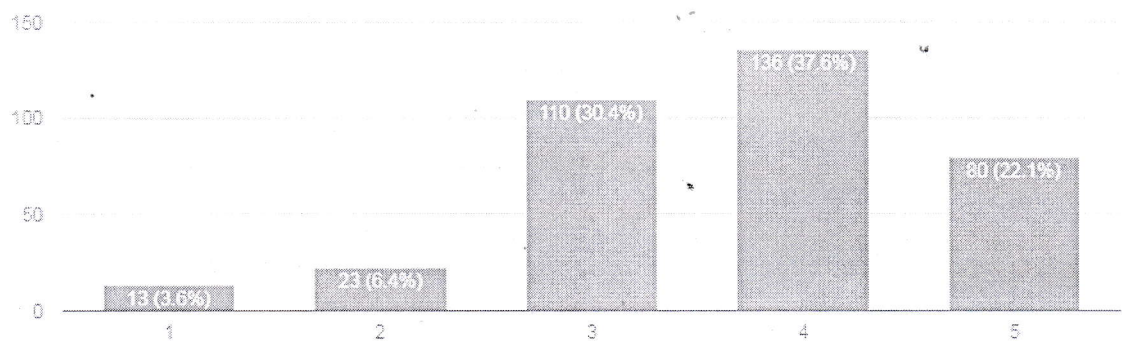


19.4% students have given highest rating on curriculum in terms of securing job whereas 4.5% have given lowest rating .

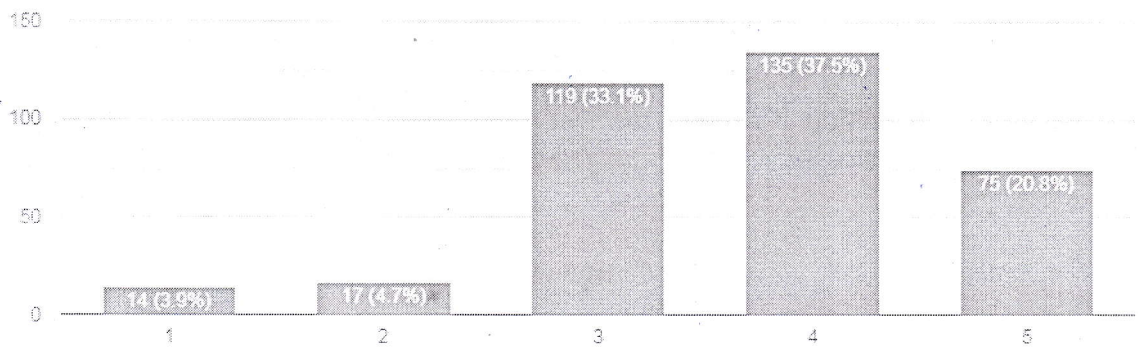


22.1% students strongly agree that the course stimulates their interest and thought on subject area and 3.6% students strongly disagree that the course stimulates their interest and thought on subject.

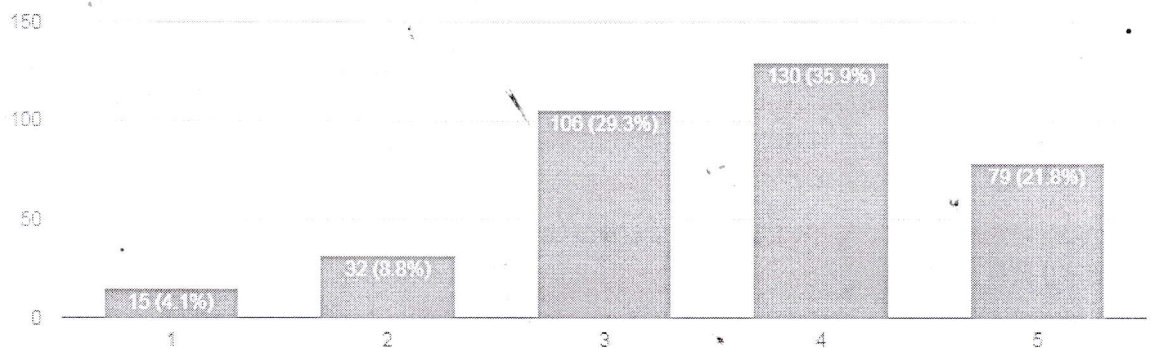


20.8% students strongly agree that the syllabus of the course is intellectually enriching where as 3.9% students strongly disagree.

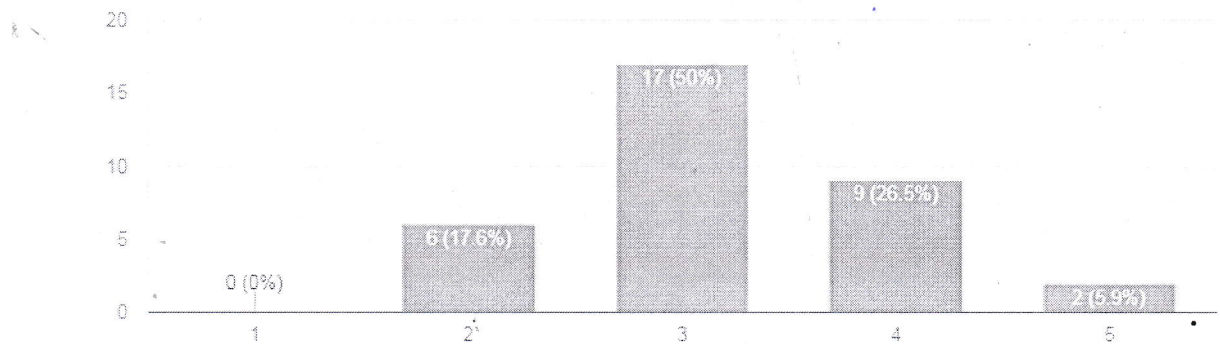
b) FACULTY

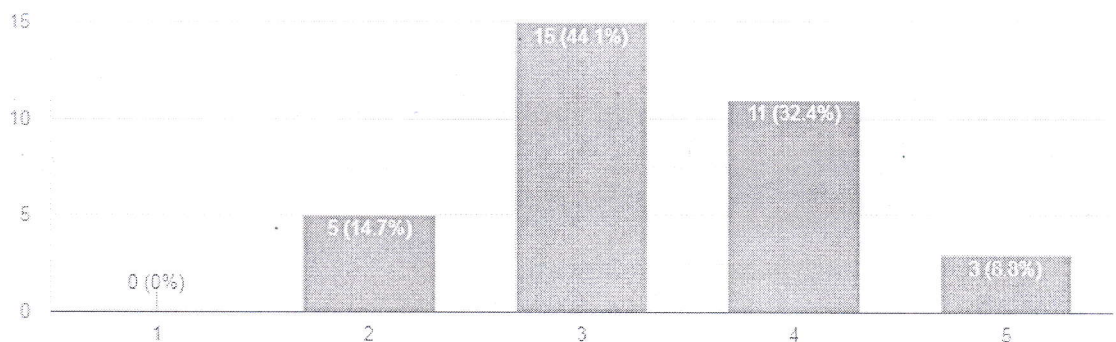


Around 6% strongly agreed and 27% faculties agreed that the content of the syllabus is appropriate for the need of the industry.

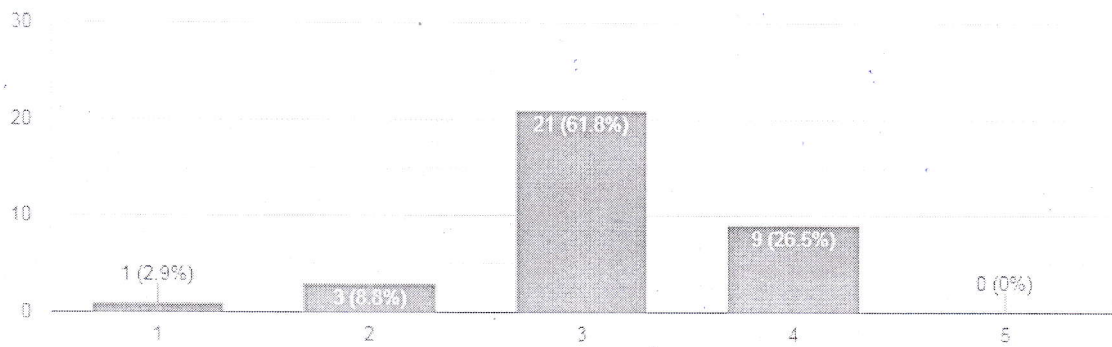


Around 9% strongly agreed and 33% faculties agreed that The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment

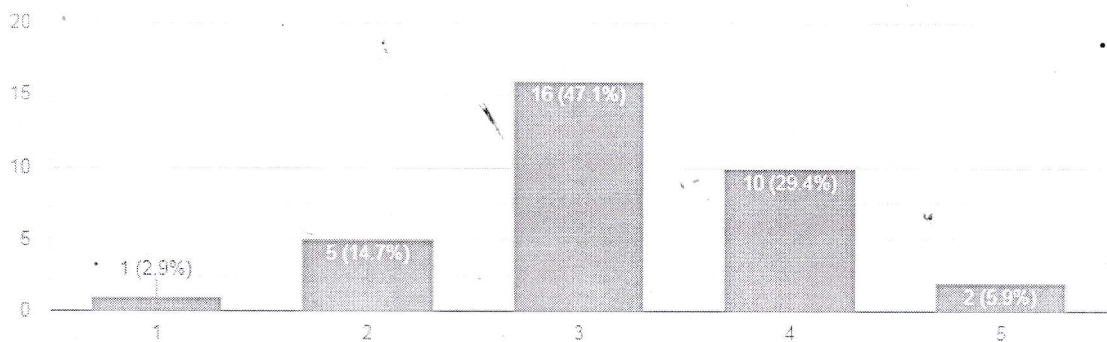


26% Agreed and 62% faculties remained neutral in The theory and practical components of the syllabus are well balanced

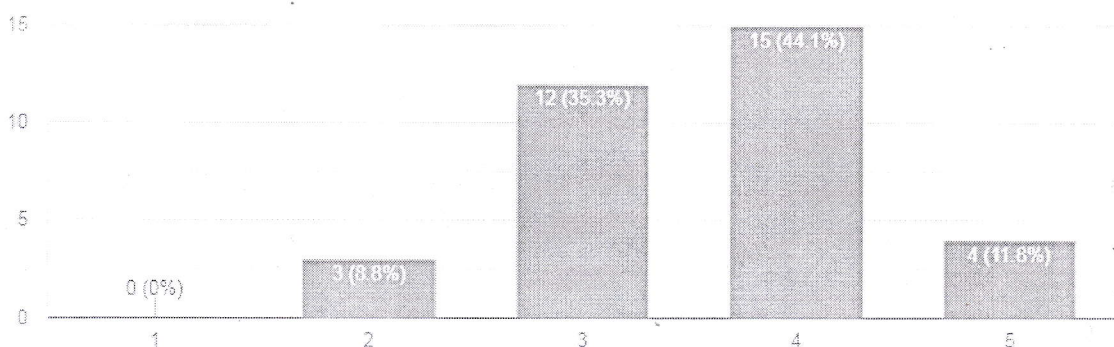

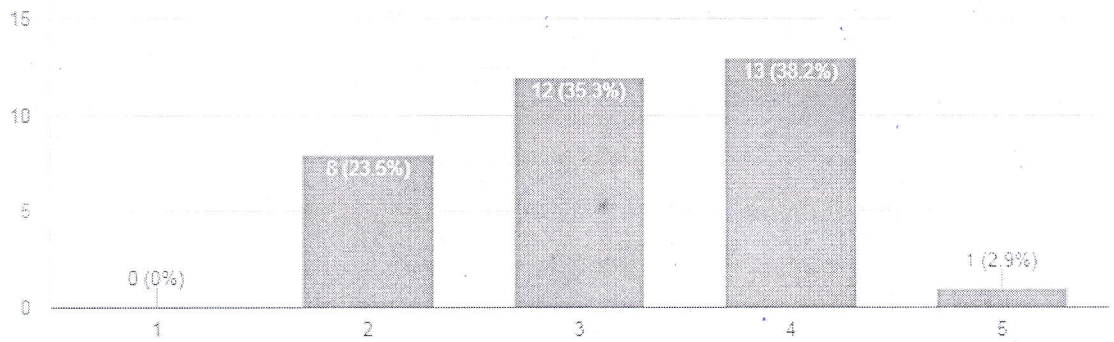

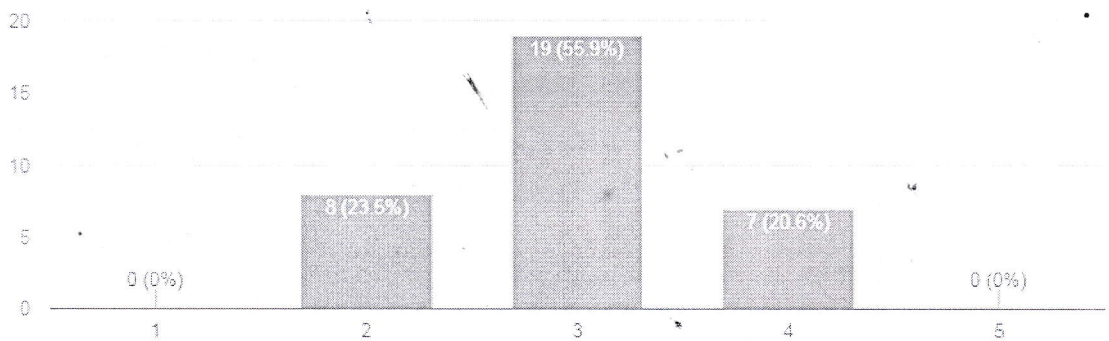

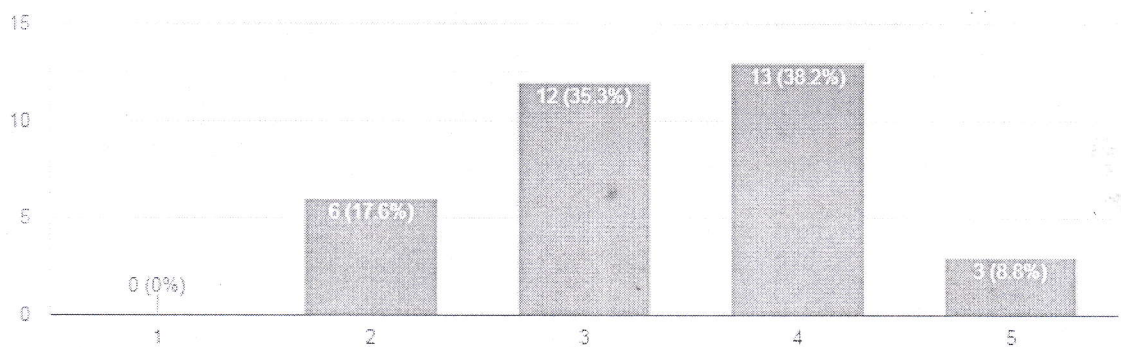

- Topics can be simplified for better understanding

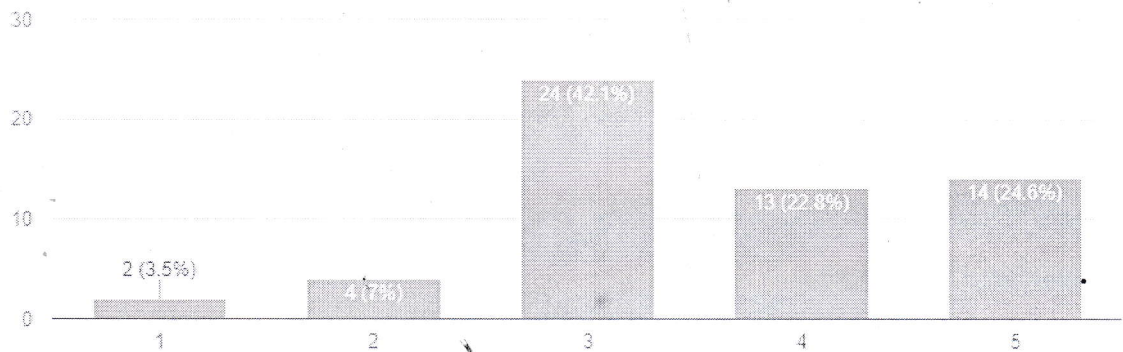
c) ALUMINI

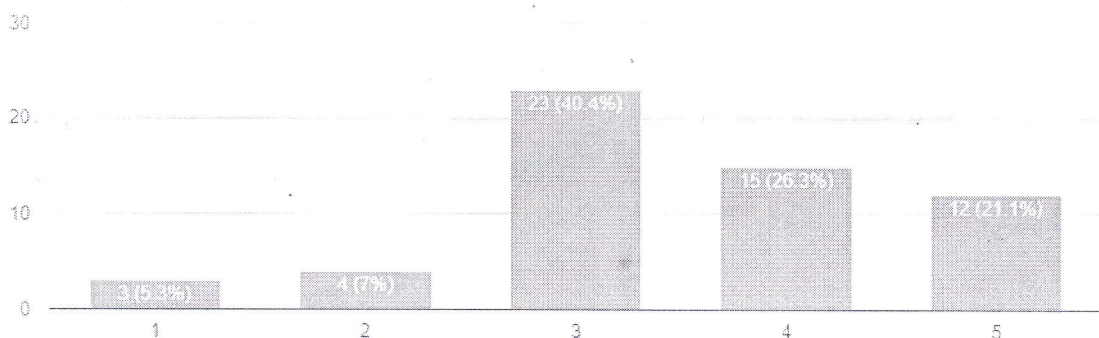


25% strongly agree and 23% agree on curriculum is updated as per industry expectation.

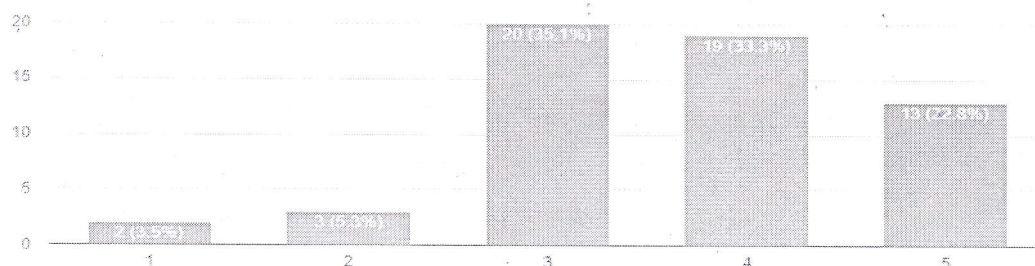


21% strongly agree and 15% agree on how the curriculum was relevant and helpful in the current working profile

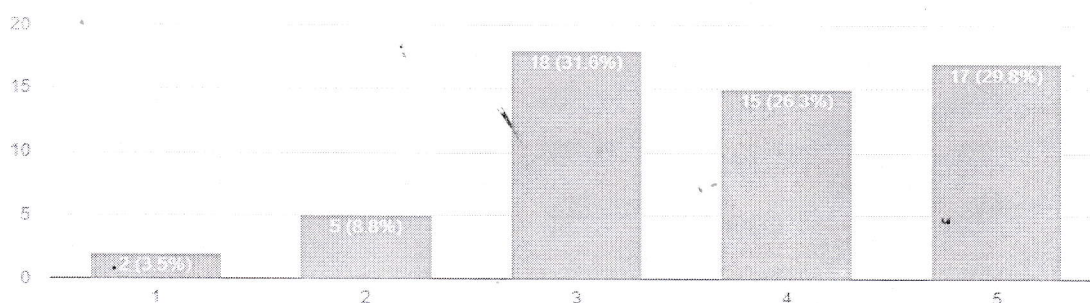


22% strongly agree and 34% agree on how curriculum was in subject domain skill enhancement.

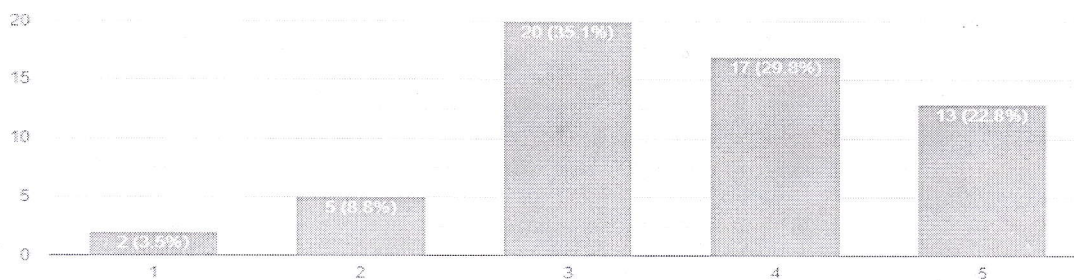


30% strongly agree and 26% agree on how curriculum was helpful to perform daily work routine

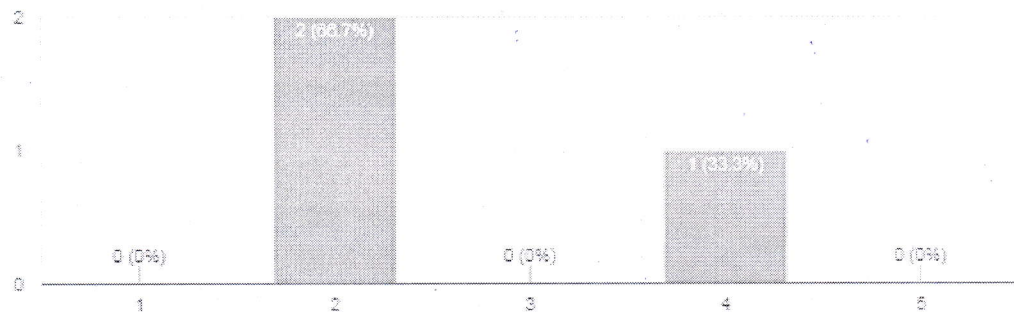

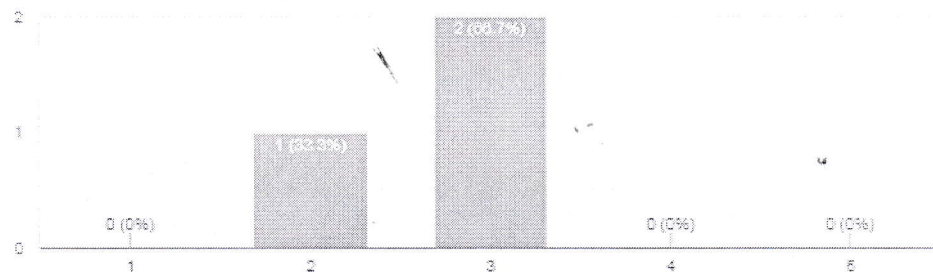

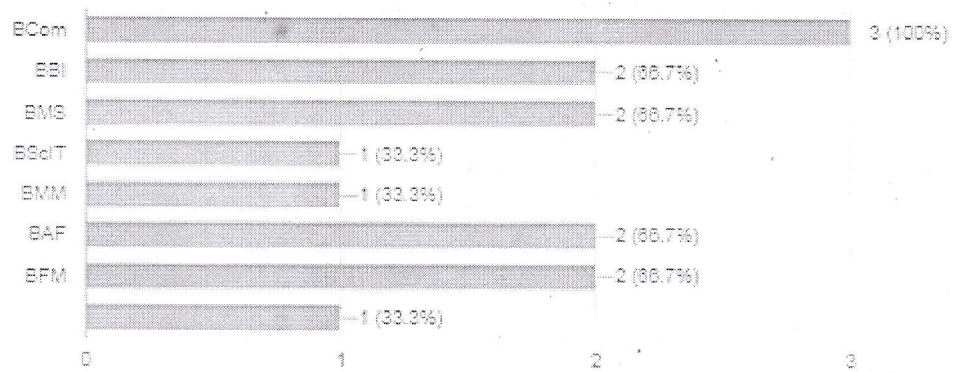

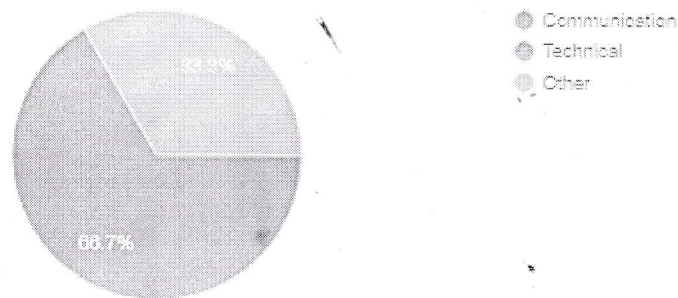

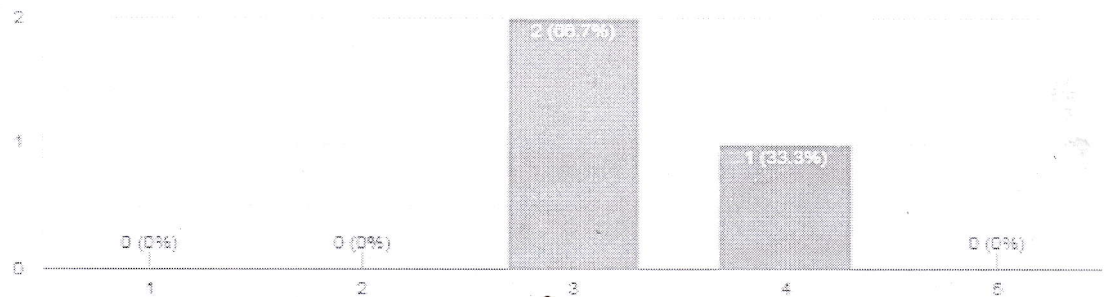
