


# Curriculum Feedback Analysis – 2023-24

#### (a) Students:


Degree 336 responses



Total 336 students has given feedback on curriculum out of which 91.1% are graduation and 8.9% from Post-graduation








Out of 361 responses 34.9 % are male respondents and 65.1% are female respondents.


# Curriculum rating in terms of securing job



19.4% students have given highest rating on curriculum in terms of securing job whereas 4.5% have given-lowest rating .




22.1% students strongly agree that the course stimulates their interest and thought on subject area and 3.6% students strongly disagree that the course stimulates their interest and thought on subject.




20.8% students strongly agree that the syllabus of the course is intellectually enriching where as 3.9% students strongly disagree.




21.8% of students strongly agree that syllabus provides hands on experience where as 4.1% strongly disagree.



# b) FACULTY




Around 6% strongly agreed and 27% faculties agreed that the content of the syllabus is appropriate for the need of the industry.




Around 9% strongly agreed and 33% faculties agreed that The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment




26% Agreed and 62% faculties remained neutral in The theory and practical components of the syllabus are well balanced




6% Strongly agreed, 30% Agreed and 47% faculties remained neutral in accepting Course stimulates student's interest and thought on the subject area




11% Strongly agreed and 44% faculties agreed that The books prescribed for reference are relevant, appropriate and updated

20% Agree and 56% faculties remained neutral for the topics of the syllabus are upgraded with current scenario




9% strongly agree and 38% faculties agree that Syllabus gives scope to teachers to adopt new and different techniques of teaching

# Suggestions received are:


- Curriculum should provide internship compulsory for Bcom student also.

#### c) ALUMINI




25% strongly agree and 23% agree on curriculum is updated as per industry expectation.




21% strongly agree and 15% agree on how the curriculum was relevant and helpful in the current working profile








